elect anybody but a Governor every twenty years in this 1 State who is a Republican, so the Board of Public Works 2 consists of a Republican Governor and two Democrats. For-3 tunately, they have been very cooperative, because the 4 Treasurer has been a high-type man who has not been involved 5 in politics, which is a blessing like John Luetkemeyer, see 6 he wouldn't play politics, but if the Comptroller and the 7 Treasurer get together, they could give the Governor a fit. 8 JUDGE ADKINS: Nay I ask a question, Mayor? 9 10 MAYOR McKELDIN: Yes. JUDGE ADKINS: In the recommendation which you 11 have made to the effect that the Comptroller should be ap-12 pointed by the Governor, is there any reason for him to 13 continue as a member of the Board of Public Works if, in 14 15 fact, we continue a Board of Public Works? 16 MAYOR McKELDIN: I wouldn't see any reason, no. He is only advisory, of course, and the Board has its ad-17 visors, I mean whether they are on the Board or not. Repeat 18 19 it again for me. JUDGE ADKINS: Well, if you make the Comptroller 20 21 appointive, as you have recommended, should he then be a
