1 that would meet with their approval. I think you would 2 be doing a great service to the State, ves. 3 MR.ENEY: Well, if you didn't abolish counties and the City of Baltimore and their separate political 5 subdivisions but created some form of metropolitan auth-6 ority for the Baltimore City area embracing Baltimore City, 7 Baltimore County, part of Harford County or all of it, 8 Howard County and Anne Arundel County, would you favor 9 giving such a metropolitan authority full power or merely 10 advisory power? 11 MAYOR McKELDIN: Of course, that's a very 12 broad question that I couldn't answer right off, but in 13 principle, I would be in favor of that. It would have to 14 be worked out, but in principle, I would be in favor of 15 I think there should be such an authority that could 16 embrace them and have a like a county government over five 17 or six of us. I think it would be much better for us. 18 JUDGE ADKINS: Which would replace the existing 19 MAYOR McKELDIN: County governments. 20 JUDGE ADKINS: -- County and City governments. 21 MAYOR McKELDIN: No, it wouldn't replace them,
