I understand it, so I don't get worried about it because 1 2 I have been in the business, and they want to keep control of the boys in the City Council, the members of the Legislature, so that's it; it is a peculiar reason, but that's it. 6 JUDGE ADXINS: Well, Governor, apparently we 7 have, or Mr. Mayor, apparently we have exhausted our 8 questions. 9 We very much appreciate your taking time to 10 help us out. If you have any other thoughts, we would be 11 very happy to receive them now even, or at any time in 12 the future. 13 MAYOR McKELDIN: Take the Governor's salary 14 out of the Constitution, let me conclude with that. 15 I think we all agree, at least JUDGE ADKINS: 16 the sub-committee, that this ought to be done. 17 MAYOR McKELDIN: No governor would put it on 18 the ballot. Being a Republican, I knew I couldn't be 19 elected again. I put it on the ballot but I fooled myself, 20 and I was elected, and it passed, they still kept it in the 21 Constitution, and increased the salary to 15,000 which, of
