2	He shouldn't, in doing that, be permitted to ignore any
3	existing law that the Legislature has produced or that the

6	case the Governor gets out of hand.
7	Should the Governor have the power to require
8	administrative departments to furnish him with information
9	That goes without saying.
10	What powers does the Governor need to fulfill
11	his functions as preparer of the budget?
