but they have got to be good friends of yours, otherwise 1 you won't succeed. I don't know why I said all that. Ż Should the Governor have the power to dele-3 gate his powers of executive clemency? 4 No, he gets advice instead, and it is usual 5 to talk, as Governor Tawes and Mayor McKeldin have said. 6 he talks to judges, he talks to almost everybody he can 7 in order to inform himself with the information he needs 8 for the exercise of it, and if it should be spread around 9 in various places, well, you run the risk of getting in a 10 11 mess. I think the Governor should accept that responsibility no matter how he works it out, and I would depend 12 on him to work it out in a creditable way, but I think 13 there is a danger in spreading it around too much. 14 15 Should the Governor have the power to grant a nolle prosequi? 16 I never heard of it before I read the Consti-17 tution, and I had no participation in any activity under 18 it, and I think it should be deleted as a dead letter. 19 Should the Governor have a veto power? 20 21 Of course.
