Then with respect to the point which you and 1 Dr. Burdett were commenting on jointly, the Maryland Municipal League now has under way an effort, if it is 3 sufficiently supported by the municipalities in this State to combine in a single volume all laws pertaining to municipalities and this could conceivably cover that which 6 you and Professor Burdett have been talking about, and at this point a determination has not been finally made as ខ to how far it will be, for the simple reason we have not 9 completed our survey; but we are working in that direction 10 Thank you. 11 I think then our research can THE CHAIRMAN: 12 tie in with your present efforts, quite obviously, but it 13 is clear, I believe that we've got to have some research 14 into the approaches to the metropolitan problems that have 15 been and can be undertaken in a constitution. 16
