3	MR. BOND: It comes from Federal, State and
4	local funds, sir. I would say about 60 per cent of it
5	from the Federal Government, but it comes into the State
6	and is allocated by this board.
7	GOVERNOR LANE: Yes.
8	MR. BOND: Of course, you have to deal with
9	the Bureau of the Budget, too.
10	GOVERNOR LANE: Yes.
11	IR. BOND: And with the Governor, but still
12	. the administrative authority for that department is vested
13	in the board which I am coming more and more to the con-
14	clusion is wrong.
15	GOVERNOR LANE: Well, the State in a sense is
16	concerned only by its contribution. I think the State
17	should have to that extent which you indicated was what,
18	40 per cent or
19	IR. BOND: It is about 30 per cent, sir, and
20	10 per cent local funds, depending on the program.
S 1	GOVERNOR LANE: 30 per cent less in authority,
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was out of the top of my head. You said 100 million dol-

lars, where does that money come from?

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
