have, or any with respect to the State of Maryland, are
you first of all familiar with our court organizational
setup and our system of selection and election of
judges that we have here in the State?
MR. WINTERS: Oh, yes. I do not suppose tha
I could pass an examination on the details of it, but
I had been familiar with it through the years, and
especially during recent months when current proposals
have been under way.
THE CHAIRMAN: You are speaking particularly
of the selection proposals?
MR. WINTERS: Yes, and removal.
THE CHAIRMAN: Have you had an opportunity,
Mr. Winters, to look at our first report on this Com-
mittee? I do not suppose you have at this point.
MR. WINTERS: Well, it was sent to me the
other day and I looked at it briefly. I'm afraid I
have not had a chance to study it through.
THE CHAIRMAN: Very, very briefly what we
have in mind at this point, it is all very tentative
