or --1 DR. BURDETT: Also authorize classification, rather than provide for it. THE CHAIRMAN: It means we are going to be changing the existing provisions in the Constitution for 5 something new. 6 DR. BURDETT: Not really, because the existing Constitution provides for municipal classifications, but 8 the Legislature has decided that there is one classifica-9 tion in Maryland. 10 MR. THOMPSON: Precisely. 11 12 DR. BURDETT: I've forgotten how many. or four? 13 MR. RATCHFORD: Four. 14 THE CHAIRMAN: And also that you can classify 15 counties into four separate classifications. 16 MR. RATCHFORD: That would be under the Code. 17 May I comment on this for a minute, because it is a para-18 doxical situation.
