voters, how does that work? 1 MR. WINTERS: What do you mean, straw vote? 2 MRS. BOTHE: This may be only in the Niles plan. It is true in other states MR. MARTINEAU: 5 too. 6 I understand many other states THE CHAIRMAN: 7 have this system, that they also provide for a straw 8 vote of the lawyers to be made public, to advise the 9 public as to how the lawyers feel about this particular 10 judge. 11 MR. WINTERS: The best ones are those that 12 have been done in the State of Ohio, several of the 13 large city associations there conduct polls and they 14 have a list of about a dozen questions asking for opinion 15 on this man's integrity, on his knowledge of the law, 16 his courtesy to the people who appear before him and so 17 forth. And those are weighted questions. I remember 18 that in most of them, integrity is given 50 per cent 19 weight, and I think promptness 10 per cent, or other 20 variations. 21
