that it gets away from the idea of personal popularity 1 and tries for personal evaluation. Of course, all of 2 those things are imperfect at best. 3 THE CHAIRMAN: Why wouldn't it be just as 4 effective in a non-competitive situation? 5 MR. WINTERS: I suppose it would. 6 MR. MARTINEAU: I do not see any reason for 7 it in a non-competitive election, because the issue is 8 not the same as the issue is in a competitive election, 9 you had to choose between two, and which one are you 10 going to vote for? One gets a 65 rating, the other one 11. gets a 75 rating, but in an non-competitive issue, the 12 simple issue is should he be retained in office? And 15 the judge in a strew poll can vote on that question for 14 any darn reason he pleases, but really the only relevant 15 question is, does the lawyer recommend that he be retained 16 in office or not? So, I do not know that there would be 17 any point in having this detailed questionnaire with the 31 weighted questions. 19 MRS. BOTHE: If you and Mr. Winters can give 20 me the time, there are a couple questions in an entirely

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
