MR. CORY: This evaluation group in California, does it work continually or only go into action upon receiving a complaint?

MR. WINTERS: Well, they evaluate the judges as a continuing matter, study their work. There are three elements in the California system. This is the commission, composed of representatives of all levels of the judiciary, plus the bar and plus the lay public, and it has regular meetings.
