the people. Any official is the representative of the
people and therefore accountable to them. That is why
the State Board of Education in my opinion is probably
the greatest body of its kind in the State because you
let the State Board do something and all of the people
in the State come after them, but there are a lot of
other bodies, a lot of other boards who are not account-

able because people don't know who they are.

MR. ENEY: Dr. Pullen, may I come back to the matter you were speaking on a moment ago, because it is not clear to me yet. Are you suggesting that free public education be extended from nursery school or kindergarten through college, a professional school, or what?

DR. PULLEN: I thought I said this, or this is what I meant to say. Yes, in principle. I would be cautious, to this extent. I would know where I could pay for it, but what are you going to do, Mr. Eney, if some parents -- and I think some parents ought to do this if some parent brings a suit against the University of Maryland or one of the colleges saying that my child is
