outside of the State. 1 The eighth question is a study of how removing 2 the Baltimore City Charter and enabling provisions from 3 the Constitution will affect Baltimore City. 4 I think we've definitely got to know that and 5 that is a study in itself. 6 MR. RATCHFORD: It's according to the effect on 7 the City government or on the City politicians? 8 I think we've got to be practical THE CHAIRMAN: 9 in the final analysis with what we come up with and we've 10 got to determine that what we are going to suggest is 11 feasible. It is a matter I touched upon with John Brooks 12 a little earlier, saying we could rewrite this Constitution 13 in five minutes, actually, but whether or not what we write 14 is going to be acceptable or is feasible is a very, very 15 important part of our consideration and we've got to know, 16 really, I think, here what removing the Baltimore City 17 Charter, what effect it is going to have and what opposi-18 19 tion it is going to engender. It is tied in, for example, in the same way 20
