necessarily that it be retained in this part. We certainly want it retained, but, I guess -- I told you the reason why I thought they chose it. Mr. Eney would know better than I would on that.

THE CHAIRLADY: Do you know of any other state constitutions which have such provisions?

MR. BURGESS: Yes. There are three or four.

I can't tell you -- New Jersey has one now, such a provision, and I know there are efforts being made in four or five other states to have such constitutional provisions. I guess this would be a general tendency particularly in the states on the eastern seaboard and on the west coast and perhaps maybe in the middle west.

THE CHAIRLADY: We certainly thank you, Mr.
