that going to have in Prince Georges County. I think 1 there has been a movement and it is clearly evident as 2 the years have gone by in the direction of acceptance of home rule, but you still have a very, very strong, wellorganized group that just doesn't like the idea. Mr. 5 Thompson? ß MR. THOMPSON: Mr. Chairman, I believe it is 7 evident to anyone reading the Constitution and the Annotated 8 Code of this State immediately that there are numerous special provisions made for the City of Baltimore. It is 10 treated as an entity virtually unto itself and virtually 11 the only kind in the State and it would appear to me it 12 might be worthy of consideration and note when one is 13 discussing the possibility of classification or categori-14 zation or however one may word that approach, of creating 15 a system which would include Baltimore City as part of an 16 over-all system, rather than regarding it as completely 17 without and beyond, and I think this may have the advantage 18 of integrating the governments and providing for more 19 intergovernmental cooperation, if indeed every local 20 governmental entity in the State is part of a State of 21
