We would be delighted to have THE CHAIRLADY: 1 2 it. DR. KUHN: And that should be considered the 3 official position of the university. In the course of 4 teaching, research and all the many various activities 5 that a university engages in, whether it is the Univer-6 sity of Maryland or any across the country, as a public 7 university, it is not unusual for the research activities 8 the information that is dispersed or disseminated to be 9 10 at variance with the popular thinking or the mood of the moment, and I think, more and more, the universities 11 have come to be regarded as centers in which there must 12 be constant search for the truth and when information is 13 developed, new knowledge is developed, this must be dis-14 persed and disseminated, and while it in no way should 15 govern the people -- all people should have access to 16 this in their deliberations to determine from among 17 various alternatives or courses of action. 18 It is not unusual when a university or its 19

faculty or its administrative people are presenting an

idea that is not necessarily in tune with the moment for
