in the Constitution, as they were in 1864. I think all of you realize the power of the Constitution, as to changing it later, because there was a real revolution in the General Assembly and they overturned the whole 1864 Constitution and they were so disturbed by the first State Superintendent, that they wanted to remove all vestiges of what he had initially tried to do.

I think Section 1, which has to do with the establishment of a system of free public schools, should contain some section which would read as follows:

Which will provide equal educational opportunies for all children.

We hear so much these days about discrimination and lack of equal opportunity, so I would suggest that we need to include in that section some reference to equal educational opportunities. Dr. Paquin made reference to thorough and efficient. He wasn't happy with it.

I don't have anything better to suggest, because people these days do make reference to quality education and, if you just say education, maybe that is
