not include such things as, well, the State Department 1 itself, and it does not include library. However, now, 2 they have been declared to be a mandated part because it 3 provides for the minimum support of libraries of \$1.20 per capita for public libraries. 5 THE CHAIRLADY: Of course, the legislature can change the amounts? 7 DR. ZIMMERMAN: Oh, yes. Anything that the 8 legislature gives, the legislature can take away. 9 other words, all this does is mandate the payment of 10 State moneys for those items which the legislature has 11 seen fit to legislate as requirements. 12 THE CHAIRLADY: So, if they wanted to get 13 around you through the back door, they would have to 14 change the appropriated amount? 15 DR. ZIMMERMAN: They would have to change the 16 basic law. 17 DR. BARD: May I give an illustration of that 18 to support Dr. Zimmerman's concept here, as it applies

to the community college, for example. The State law

has made it clear that there will be State matching funds
