It is suggested that Article 43 could be amended with the elimination of this last sentence which has been discussed so thoroughly. It is suggested that Article 8, Section 1 could be updated. On Section 2, they thought maybe some different wording could be used, if it is to be done, inasmuch as the school system is already established, and the other one, Section 3, it is believed particularly to leave this provision intact; and the other thought we have, could you identify more particularly what are school funds.
