Article 43. Similarly, it is my opinion that Article 43 is one of the most satisfying definitions of education which I have ever read in more than thirty years of experience in the teaching profession. Although many people will read it hurriedly and say, what does it mean, there is, in my opinion, no better definition of education than the first sentence of Article 43. I strongly urge its retention without change.

Now, my good friend, Mr. Burgess was talking about agriculture and I seemed to sense that maybe he thought that ought to be pulled out. Agriculture is not mentioned here in terms of a specific subject, other than that we educate for agriculture, and I urge you to give consideration to that, because it is a beautiful statement and I think there is just as much reason for having agriculture there as there is science and all the other statements that have been made. So far as I am concerned I would hope you would not change it.

I hold strongly for the traditions and heritage which have come down to us from our forefathers and believe that such statements, as Articles 36 and 43,
