The tenth item is a study of how other states have resolved the question of city-county conflicts.

There again, I think we are interested in knowing what others have had by way of experience in connection with this problem. We are running into the problem. We are going to run into it more and more as we try to make provision for it in the constitution, and we want to know what others have done. Mr. Thompson?

NR. THOMPSON: Mr. Chairman, I might add,
