additional subject for research or more or less in conjunction with this question, by enlarging it, what has been done by way of establishing a department of state and local affairs and, in conjunction with that, what if any provision has been made in any constitution of any state for the creation of a department of state and local governmental affairs.

Now, Mrs. Freedlander has brought to my attention the efforts being made in that direction in Pennsylvania and apparently, right now, there is a bill which is before the Governor for signature setting up a department of community affairs, or some such name, and I asked her to send a copy of that bill and it did reach me by the last mail before I left the office, and it is certainly one where I think not only what is being done in Pennsylvania, but what is being done or has been done in any other state would certainly be a matter for us to determine.

By an article which appears to be part of a Senate Bill No. 1144, Session 1965, the bill before the Governor is one which bears the caption, Powers and Duties of the Department of Community Affairs, Its Departmental
