created free and equal, everybody believes it, agrees 1 with it. 2 MR. SYKES: I beg your pardon on that specific 3 one. MR. GENTRY: It's in writing --5 MR. SYKES: Now, the Declaration of Independence 6 said all men are created equal and then Thomas Jefferson 7 went ahead and established a school system in which 8 different people got different types of schooling because 9 he knew they weren't created free and equal. I think 10 what the thrust of that language in the Declaration of 11 Independence is that all men should have equal oppor-12 tunities and a freedom to exercise those opportunities, 13 but it is significant to me --14 THE CHAIRMAN: You wouldn't put that in the 15 Bill of Rights, the phrase you just mentioned? 16 MR. SYKES: What? 17 MR. GENTRY: For instance, on education, 18 equal education opportunities for all children in the 19 State; would you include that? 20 MR. SYKES: Let me go on and point out what I 21
