MR. BURGESS: Yes. I think it is interesting, 1 in the Constitution of 1851, how they added the last 2 clauses, which were not included in the Constitution of 3 1776. You are also pressing for THE CHAIRMAN: 5 Article 4? 6 MR. BURGESS: May I also -- yes, Article 4. 7 Do you want me to read that? I have it here. 8 THE CHAIRMAN: That the people of this State 9 have the sole and exclusive right of regulating the 10 internal government and police thereof, as a free, 11 sovereign and independent State. 12 MR. BURGESS: Right. 13 And the other article? THE CHAIRMAN: 14 MR. BURGESS: That would be 6 and 7. 15 THE CHAIRMAN: That refers to the power of 16 the Legislature. 17 MR. BURGESS: Right. 18 THE CHAIRMAN: And Article 7, That the right 19 of the people to participate in the legislature is the 20 best security of liberty and the foundation of all free 21
