

1 MR. BURGESS: Yes. I think it is interesting,
2 in the Constitution of 1851, how they added the last
3 clauses, which were not included in the Constitution of
4 1776.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: You are also pressing for
6 Article 4?

7 MR. BURGESS: May I also -- yes, Article 4.
8 Do you want me to read that? I have it here.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: That the people of this State
10 have the sole and exclusive right of regulating the
11 internal government and police thereof, as a free,
12 sovereign and independent State.

13 MR. BURGESS: Right.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: And the other article?

15 MR. BURGESS: That would be 6 and 7.

16 THE CHAIRMAN: That refers to the power of
17 the Legislature.

18 MR. BURGESS: Right.

19 THE CHAIRMAN: And Article 7, That the right
20 of the people to participate in the legislature is the
21 best security of liberty and the foundation of all free
