questions that I can, that you want to ask.

MRS. FREEDLANDER: I would just like to ask you would you have any objection to an article that would be entitled the Legislature -- and this is in the process of being reviewed, as we are reviewing the Declaration of Rights, if we embodied in that the time and place of the Legislature and the frequency of meetings and that kind of thing? We have a very short Bill of Rights within the U. S. Constitution, which you mentioned, and here we have forty-some articles that we have had more or less over the years in the varying constitutions. Would you have any objection to their being within an article under the Legislature rather than here? And, with reference to your point on the militia, we had a hearing with Generals Reckord, Ogletree and Gelston, and they felt that these articles could very well be under a militia article. We do have a militia article and then we have these. Would you have any objection to including what is presently under the Declaration of Rights in a militia article? They had no objection to that when we questioned them.
