1	seizure of power in 1966. As a matter of fact, when you
2	think about tyranny, really, when we think about that, we
,3	had 3,000,000 people in the United States at that time,
4	the same number of people we have in Maryland today, when
5	Patrick Henry made his speech in Virginia, and now we
6	have almost 190,000,000 people; and they talked about
7	tyranny then as a small thing. We just had a couple of
8	episodes of that and fought a war about it.
9	THE CHAIRMAN: Thank you very much. Dr.
10	Zimmerman?
11	DR. DAVID W. ZIMMERMAN: I don't have a pre-
12	pared statement. I came primarily as an observer. I do
13	want to reiterate what I said when I was before the
14	Commission. /
