the sole and exclusive right of regulating the internal government thereof as a free, sovereign and independent State, subject only to the powers delegated specifically to the United States by the Constitution thereof and that all other powers and authority are reserved unto the respective states or the people thereof, do declare:

"I would then suggest that Article 1 be used to replace present Articles 1, 4, 6 and 7, Article 1 to read as follows:

"Article 1. That all government of right originates from the people and is instituted for the good of the whole, its principal agency being the Legislature through which the plenary powers of government are exercised; that the right of the people to participate in the Legislature is the best security of liberty and the foundation of all free government and for this purpose free elections shall be held frequently, when every citizen having the qualifications prescribed by the Constitution ought to have the right of suffrage.

"I would have no hesitancy whatever in eliminating Articles 4, 6 and 7. I concur completely with Mr. Brooks
