2	course, is obsolete with reference to slavery, 28, 29,
3	30, 31, and 32, having to do with maintenance of militia
4	standing armies, subordination of military power to civi
5	power, quartering of soldiers and marshal law. I concur
6	that Article 41 with reference to monopolies and 42 pro-
7	viding that no title of nobility be granted, should be
8	eliminated.

"It is my understanding a Declaration of Rights should be only a statement of rights reserved for the people, notwithstanding the fact that these rights may be given protection -- and I think they generally are -- by the United States Constitution.

"I am not sure this has been very helpful to you, but it may give you something from which you can digest a statement to go to Mr. Brooks after you have incorporated the thinking of other members of the Executive Committee."

Now, the other members of the Executive

Committee studied this, they got it before I saw it

today, and they have concurred in Mr. Beatty's statement.
