

1 suggestion to eliminate Articles 10, 11, 12, 24 which, of
2 course, is obsolete with reference to slavery, 28, 29,
3 30, 31, and 32, having to do with maintenance of militia,
4 standing armies, subordination of military power to civil
5 power, quartering of soldiers and marshal law. I concur
6 that Article 41 with reference to monopolies and 42 pro-
7 viding that no title of nobility be granted, should be
8 eliminated.

9 "It is my understanding a Declaration of
10 Rights should be only a statement of rights reserved for
11 the people, notwithstanding the fact that these rights
12 may be given protection -- and I think they generally
13 are -- by the United States Constitution.

14 "I am not sure this has been very helpful to
15 you, but it may give you something from which you can
16 digest a statement to go to Mr. Brooks after you have
17 incorporated the thinking of other members of the
18 Executive Committee."

19 Now, the other members of the Executive
20 Committee studied this, they got it before I saw it
21 today, and they have concurred in Mr. Beatty's statement.
