I might also say that the Advisory Commission 1 on Intergovernmental Relations has recommended this as 2 part of its suggested State legislation for a number of 3 years. Again, this is readily available from the Advisory Commission. Personally, I have some reservations about it. 5 but as it has been indicated, it is primarily a statutory type of thing, but it would be useful and New York, I think, has had more experience than any other state on Я the operational level, to the best of my knowledge. So, as I say, we will give Mr. Brooks a few 10 more people to write to and check with. 11 THE CHAIRMAN: I would like also included in 12 13

our study just exactly what we have done here in Maryland along that line. Frankly, I just do not know. It is something I would want to know and do feel would be important.
