

1 look ahead, as you suggest, and this is a different point
2 which we are straddling. If you look ahead, it will be
3 more and more of a bureaucratic society, where more and
4 more decision making will be made by boards, as they are
5 today, various regulatory commissions and boards that
6 make decisions.

7 Now, the last Constitution has a provision
8 that protects the citizens on the power of investigatory
9 commissions of the executive and legislative branch,
10 which protects the people, which they don't currently
11 have.

12 MR. SYKES: Are you sure of it?

13 MRS. FREEDLANDER: In most state constitutions,
14 aside from Alaska. For instance, Alaska states the right
15 of all persons to fair and just treatment in the course
16 of legislative investigation shall not be infringed upon.
17 This is one of the bills of rights put out by the Municipal
18 League. Is this the kind of provision you think we should
19 consider in looking ahead?
