1 let's not put it in. MR. SYKES: I don't say it can't be done. 2 THE CHAIRMAN: I was waiting for you to con-3 test that. You are a lawyer. MR. SYKES: I'm not saying it can't be done 5 or, in fact, that it should be tried. I'm saying to you 6 the best way to find out whether it can be done is to 7 I wouldn't confess that it is impossible in 8 I just don't know and I think that maybe you 9 can let some of the non-lawyers and the lawyers spend 10 time until they have convinced themselves, a, that it -11 can be done, it's worthwhile or, b, that it isn't worth 12 the effort, 13 THE CHAIRMAN: Lawyers use the standard test, 14 15 is it legally enforceable. MR. SYKES: No, you don't have to --.16 THE CHAIRMAN: This is not the proper standard! 17 I am not restricting it to that. I am restricting it to 18 the question of how useful -- I am discussing the ques-19 tion of what would be the effect of incorporating 20 specific provisions which are not legally enforceable, 21
