

1 but beyond that, I think you are limiting your view, if
2 you are concerned with the educational value of the
3 Constitution in the school system, you are limiting
4 your view of how a constitution can be used. I happen
5 to know that people in primary and secondary education
6 are now concerning themselves with more illuminating
7 of the Federal Constitution and there is no reason why
8 it couldn't be done with the State Constitution, illumi-
9 nating the Constitution not merely from the text, not
10 merely from historic sources of the Constitution itself,
11 but also in context of the decisions of the highest
12 courts interpreting that Constitution and a great deal
13 of activity is being engaged upon now by educational
14 people toward this end to use the Constitution, as I
15 said, the Federal Constitution, and it could be the
16 State as well, as a general education in the context of
17 the presentation. Thank you.
