problems that we find that the convention is going to necessarily have to confront.

> Dr. Bard is the Chairman of the Committee on Legislative Department of the Constitution and, as such, he will preside at this meeting and explain to you the purpose of the memorandum which has heretofore been sent to all of you. We realize that we want your views not merely on the legislative department and, in discussing this with Bill and Marvin, we decided that instead of trying to get your entire group to meet a half-dozen, or seven times, really, with seven different committees of our group, that we would ask your entire group to meet with us with this Legislative Department Committee because this is the area you are going to have the most decided views about and then through, I guess we call them informal subcommittees, don't we, Bill, which you as Chairman of your group designate certain members to meet with certain individuals of our committees in an effort to avoid putting too much burden on all of them.

The thing I want to emphasize, though, is we would like to get your views on any and all provisions
