State inspection is, to a Marylander, quite a new exper-1 ience, but this becomes quite a fundamental question as to whether or not that can be provided in the Constitution or whether or not it would simply be permissible. undoubtedly permissible now, I suppose. Let's take a short recess at THE CHAIRMAN: this point. 7 (At this point there was a short recess.) 8 THE CHAIRMAN: Now that we are back on the record, may I ask for any additions or suggested addi-10 11 tions of research questions? MR. THOMPSON: Mr. Chairman, do we simply by 12 your statement on the record before extend this latter 1.3 question to include the relations between city and the 14 state and the county and state, or is it necessary to 15 16 make that statement as a separate enlargement at this 17 time? 18 THE CHAIRMAN: No. I think it is a suggestion that clarifies the discussion and I think really could 19 20 be included in this study and in this assignment, and wo can more aptly phrase the question before it is actually 21
