5 We are lingering on this question a bit longer
6 because, as Senator James has said, this is a key question.

7 DELEGATE MOORE: I would like to say, Doctor,
8 that I concur, I think, generally, in the remarks of
9 Senator Curran, although I know we are all very much
10 influenced by the comments of Senator James, President
11 of the Senate, who has served for so long in both houses.
12 I think I feel, too, the importance of a check and
13 balance system. Senator James has suggested this could
14 be built into a unicameral setup. This I would like to
15 have further comment on, if we have time.

16 I think, too, that while I state that I am
17 in concurrence with the idea of keeping the present
18 system, I think it should also be understood that the
19 present system needs improvement and that one of the
20 things which Senator James referred to, the matter of
21 legislative services and full-time positions, these are
