	DELEGATE MANDEL: I would hope that each county
1	
2	would have a representative in the House. I think that
3	under our present setup, I think that this serves a
4	valuable purpose, but the more that the court makes
5	decisions, I think we're getting more and more away from
6	even county form of government, and I'm just wondering
7	how long in the future it's going to be before this may
8	be outmoded. I don't know.
9	THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Hughes, you have been rather
10	quiet. Would you care to get into this?
11	SENATOR HUCHES: I've always been a believer
12	in the two-house system, when you have the obvious reasons
13	for it, checks and balances, but now under the one man-
14	one vote, I must admit I have difficulty in finding the
15	justification for it. There may be. I don't think just
16	simply that because you have two houses, that that's
17	justification for it, in itself, and with the one man-one
18	vote principle, the checks and balances to me seem to be
19	gone.
20	I think you have to consider also that under
01	our system in Maryland, both houses are really identical
