3 population area to a great population area as that Bay
4 Bridge opens on the other side of the Chesapeake.

5 Whether or not that would cause any continued
6 amendments to the Constitution is what I was saying. You
7 don't agree they're going to shift over there?

8 THE CHAIRMAN: No, but I had a feeling the
9 Bay Bridge would get into this discussion today. Now
10 that it has come in, I think we all feel a little relieved
11 that that has been taken care of.

12 MR. H A R V E Y : : Let me ask a question.
13 If I understand you correctly, Senator James, you feel
14 if you are going to have a home rule situation as
15 described here, that that would tend more towards
16 districts as far as legislative representation is con-
17 cerned and you would not have the county line?

18 SENATOR JAMES: As I interpret it, you are
19 interpreting this as districts more and more all the time
20 and you are becoming bolder in seizing legislative
21 prerogatives in drawing district lines, and the recent
