DELEGATE MANDEL: I was just thinking of an answer to this and I don't think it's a problem you can discuss this evening. I wonder whether Baltimore City should remain as a separate entity in the Constitution or should it not be part of the county?

THE CHAIRMAN: We are discussing that particular point.

MR. ENEY: Part of the county?

THE CHAIRMAN: No, not part of the county.

We are discussing, the Commission has at some time or

other, in terms of separate attention, under Article 11A,

but we have not made any decision in regard to any of

this.

DELEGATE MANDEL: Because I think, and the reason I say that, I think ultimately with the court decisions, that these lines are not going to mean too much, when you come up to make a legislative body for your districts, because the court, as Bill said, the court is tightening these figures down to a point where you are not going to be able to retain these lines for the purpose of a legislative body.
