Southern Maryland, you're going to have Anne Arundel 1 County with the bulk of the population. In Western 2 Maryland you will have -- the theory is do we want all 3 the power vested in Annapolis or do we want to retain --4 MR. ENEY: What do you think? 5 SENATOR CURRAN: Personally, I feel, and I 6 may be labeled whatever it might be labeled, I prefer it 7 not be localized. 8 DELEGATE MANDEL: I want to be practical on 9 some of these things. Do you want to adopt a new 10 Constitution? By that I mean, if you're going to tear 11 everything apart, you are not going to adopt anything. 12 MR. CLAGETT: It is very important to hear 13 your comments, and we are and have been very carefully 14 considering these points, both pro and con. 15

THE CHAIRMAN: Would you like to comment on that, Mr. Mandel? You have a key point here. Do you feel the nature of this question is such that it would impinge on whether or not a new Constitution could be adopted? Would you care to clarify that?

DELEGATE MANDEL: I say that because I think
