Therefore, I do not think that the smaller the house the more effective and better the government. I tend to a larger body, for the very reason that this committee itself --

DELEGATE EMANUEL: I say no less than the

THE CHAIRMAN: : How large?

House of Delegates itself. This committee itself, when we started out today, mentioned, with 35 members making study, you have two men on a committee here, five on a committee there, and you are not effective and I feel this way in the legislature.

THE CHAIRMAN: Does anyone else want to comment on Mr. Emanuel's point before -- let's move to 2: What should be the term of members of the legislature? Here is a very nice question for you. As you know, some states have terms of two years, some have staggered terms, four years and even, in some cases, beyond that.
