

1 How long would you make the term of the
2 members of the legislature and, if bicameral, would
3 you vary it for the Senate or the House, as Congress
4 says? What would you do in this respect, Mr. Moore?

5 DELEGATE MOORE: I'd say a minimum of four
6 years and a maximum of four years, in both houses,
7 the way it is now. I think certainly two years would
8 be too small a term.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you stagger it?

10 DELEGATE MOORE: I would not stagger it.

11 THE CHAIRMAN: You would have them all
12 elected at the same time?

13 DELEGATE MOORE: As we have it in the
14 present system.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Does anyone else have a
16 feeling about that? We would like to get your feeling
17 on this question. This has taken a good deal of our
18 attention at committee meetings.

19 DELEGATE KIRCHER: I feel the same, Dr. Bard,
20 as Mr. Moore, that a two-year term is too short, entirely
21 too short. In other words, with a new member coming into
