the makeup of the legislature at any one time."

So that you defeat the voice of the people by this use of the staggered term. It's impossible for people in an election to clean house, get control over the legislature. I think that is a serious defect.

The other thing, I think our elections are held in nonpresidential years and I think it's a great virtue in having our State elections in nonpresidential years only. It keeps the State elections separate from the Federal elections.

THE CHAIRMAN: It looks like we've hit upon unanimity on this question. Let's move to Question 3. Here is an interesting question. Some of you don't know that some years ago Governor McKeldin put me on a commission dealing with increasing the compensation of the members of the legislature. We had a marvelous recommendation to increase.

What provisions, if any, should be put in the Constitution? Would you put anything in the Constitution concerning, as it now is, as you know, concerning the compensation of members of the legislature?
