2 SENATOR HUGHES: I don't think the amount
3 should be in the Constitution.

4 MR. ENEY: There shouldn't be anything said,
5 now?

6 SENATOR HUGHES: Well, what it says now is,
7 as provided by law, which is the same provision as the
8 Attorney General or anyone else.

9 SENATOR JAMES: You might say provided by
10 statute. In that event, you could put it to a petition
11 for referendum.

12 SENATOR HUGHES: I think in Delaware a change
13 in the legislators' salary has to be passed in two
14 successive terms of the legislature.

15 THE CHAIRMAN: Delaware does not have a
16 referendum; is that right?

17 MR. BROOKS: You are probably right. There
18 are a number of states that require successive votes
19 on a number of issues, including salary.
