review the ground we covered at the last meeting for the benefit of all.

DR. LOEVY: At the last meeting, the general question was again what should be the proper unit of local government. Reporter Jones suggested that we should look at local government problems, in other words, see just what problems local governments were facing, before deciding what unit of government would be best for the State of Maryland.

Judge Adkins suggested that in his opinion the best form of government would be to keep the counties and that any metropolitan form of government should be strictly voluntary. He opposed the idea of pinning any form of metropolitan government down in constitutional language.
