2 Now, the only time that it takes up the time
3 of the legislature itself is what it gets on the floor
4 of the house and the local bills usually, 99 per cent
5 of the time don't consume that much time.

6 THE CHAIRMAN: You think 90 days would be
7 better?

8 DELEGATE MANDEL: I think so, because your
9 State is growing. Even if you eliminate your local
10 legislation, the growth of this State is going to require
11 more time to its bigger problems.

12 MR. CLAGETT: What percentage of the legis-
13 lature's working time during attendance at a session of
14 the legislature is taken up with legislation?

15 DELEGATE MANDEL: It depends on where you are
16 from. In Prince George's County, it's 110 per cent.

17 DELEGATE EMANUEL: I'll testify before your
18 committee on that.

19 MR. CLAGETT: Before I lose the consensus,
20 though, what would be the average amount or percentage
21 of time of the individual legislator?
