normal fashion. 1 Now, the only time that it takes up the time 2 of the legislature itself is what it gets on the floor 3 of the house and the local bills usually, 99 per cent of the time don't consume that much time. 5 THE CHAIRMAN: You think 90 days would be 6 better? 7 DELEGATE MANDEL: I think so, because your 8 State is growing. Even if you eliminate your local legislation, the growth of this State is going to require 10 more time to its bigger problems. 11 MR. CLAGETT: What percentage of the legis-12 lature's working time during attendance at a session of 13 the legislature is taken up with legislation? 14 DELEGATE MANDEL: It depends on where you are 15 In Prince George's County, it's 110 per cent. from. 16 DELEGATE EMANUEL: I'll testify before your 17 committee on that. 18 MR. CLAGETT: Before I lose the consensus, 19 though, what would be the average amount or percentage 20 of time of the individual legislator?
