at 9:45, and there is a clock directly before me. 1 Senator, do you want to comment on either or 2 both of those, either the one about the clergy or the 3 one about vacancies? SENATOR JAMES: Well, on the clergy, I think 5 that would be up to the voters. With respect to the vacancies, my answer would be depending on the size of 7 the body. If you have a relatively small body, such as A one, an organization of which I spoke, 60 to 70, with 9 30 or 35 districts and two representatives, I personally 10 would recommend a special election, to see whether we 11 could have an election, for the simple reason that I 12 think -- besides /the legislature, we have a big turnover. 13 It seems to me you almost have to go to appointment by 14 the Governor. 15 THE CHAIRMAN: Would you use the same require-16 ments if the appointment were by the Governor, as are now 17 true? 18 SENATOR JAMES: No, I would give the Governor 19

DELEGATE MANDEL: The Governor doesn't have
